Saidawa, Bauchi, sustained varying degree of injuries in the accident.

He further stated that the scene of the accident was visited by police motor traffic division attached to GRA police station, while the victims were rushed to the Abubakar Tafawa Balewa University Teaching Hospital (ATBUTH) in Bauchi for medical attention.

According to him, they were admitted and responding to treatment, adding that the remains of the driver had been released to relatives for burial after post-mortem examination.

A 29-year-old driver, Musa Mohammed, was killed yesterday morning in Wuntin Dada area of Bauchi metropolis in which five passengers travelling from Jos, the Plateau State capital, to Bauchi, sustained various degrees of injuries.

According to a statement made available to journalists yesterday by the police public relations officer (PPRO), Bauchi Command, Haruna Mohammed, the fatal accident occurred when the driver, who was running at high speed, lost control of the vehicle and hit a stationary Iveco Eurostar truck parked by the roadside.

DSP Mohammed said that the five passengers in the vehicle, Bashir Garba, 28, of Durumi Biyu quarters, Bauchi; Aminu Haruna, 30, from Wuntin Dada, Bauchi; Ishaya Ibrahim, 23, of Dutse Alhaji, Abuja; Abdulrahman Yahaya, 18, from Dabe in Ganjuwa LGA of Bauchi State and Tijjani Ahmed, 42, of Zangon
