STRANGE: Teacher Dies Shouting Of Evil Spirit Attack

What looks like melodrama yesterday enveloped Issele-uku community, Aniocha Local Government Area of Delta State when the news of a 48-year-old female teacher at Martin Primary School in the community was reported to have died in mysterious circumstances.

Reports said that the woman, identified as Mrs. Constance Ohuegbunem, died after taking her breakfast on Monday and was

preparing to go work.

Sources said that, in a shocking drama, she was said to have undresed in her room, and shouted that unidentified spirits were haunting her. Then she slumped and died on the spot.

It was gathered that before her death, she had told some of her relations about two of her dreams, indicating in one of the dreams she was buried with white wrappers.

Her husband, Raphael Ohuegbunem who spoke to our correspondent, lamented that she died when she was needed most to

assist the family.

The council boss, Hon. Chucks Osemen, wept uncontrollably as they described her as a humble and caring teacher, saying her demise had created a vacuum that will be difficult to fill.
