Multiple Accidents Claim 6 In Edo

No fewer than six person lost their lives along the Auchu-Benin expressway on Saturday evening causing heavy traffic gridlock.

The accident occurred at Okhuo village near a dangerous spot known as "Aso Rock." It involved two heavy duty trucks, two Audi cars, one Honda and a Mercedes Benz car. A police officer who rushed to the scene had a hectic time in salvaging the wreckage from the accident scene.

Eyewitnesses said a truck and a car had a collision before a third truck that apparently had a brake failure ran into them and other cars in the opposite direction, killing five occupants on the spot.

The bodies of the victims had been taken away before reporters arrived at the scene.

Edo Sector Commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps, Familoni Oluwasusi, confirmed the incident but said he was yet to be fully briefed.
