## 2 Die, 16 Critically Injured In Ogun Auto Crash

GBENGA ADEBOYE, Abeokuta

At least two persons have been confirmed dead, while 16 others were critically injured in a multiple auto crash which occurred at Onipepeye village along the Sagamu-Abeokuta expressway, yesterday.

The accident, which claimed the life of a MAPOLY student identified as Adekoya Emmanuel in-

volved a Mercedes Benz Jeep 500 ML with registration number (LAGOS) KRD 933 BC and two fully loaded passenger buses; a white coloured Mazda marked (OGUN) XC 878 JBD, a NISSAN bus marked (OGUN) SRA 229 XA.

It was gathered that the driver of the Mercedes 500 ML coming out of Abeokuta, lost control of the car, skidded off its lane and

rammed into one of the passenger buses coming towards Abeokuta before the second bus also unknowingly rammed into them.

The public relations officer (PRO) of the state Traffic Compliance and Enforcement agency (TRACE) Babatunde Akinbiyi who confirmed the accident explained that both the MAPOLY student and the driver of one of the buses

died on the spot.

TRACE PRO further said that 12 out of the critically injured passengers were rescued to a private hospital in the Panseke area of Abeokuta, while four others including a seven year-old girl were rescued to the State Hospital in Ijaye.

He explained that the sum of N150, 000 was recovered from the scene of the crash.
