AUTO CRASH: 3 Feared Dead In Delta

Tragedy struck near Double Delight
Eatery along the Sapele/Agbor
Expressway, yesterday as a Toyota
Hilux van rammed into a commercial
taxi carrying five passengers, leaving
the students and the driver dead while
three other passengers sustained
injuries.

One of the victims, Akpoveta Justice, who is a graduate of mass communication, DELSU, told our correspondent in Delta that he had boarded a jetty car from the Abraka

market.

"After the Double Delight fast food, a Toyota Hilux was coming from the opposite direction. I noticed he was about overtaking a jeep, but there was not enough space for the Hilux to balance itself, so it was unable to return because the jeep was on a high speed and there was not enough space for him to pass through. All of a sudden, what we heard was a blast and I saw myself on the floor. Information reaching us is that the driver also died two days later."

A witnesse said some passersby rushed to the scene of the accident and helped the injured victims to the

hospital.

According to a source, the Hilux driver reported himself to the Abraka police station. At the time of filing this report, another passenger was said to have died of internal bleeding.
