There was heavy silence among top commanders of the Joint Military Task Force code named Operation Restore Hope following the Friday invasion of a military post at Kolo Creek in Ogbia local government area of the state by unknown gunmen and carting away of high calibre military weapon known as General Purpose Machine Gun (GPMG).

LEADERSHIP Sunday gathered that the invasion of the military post, which was mounted directly close to the gas facility owned by the Shell Petroleum Development Company (SPDC), caught the soldiers unaware and led to the killing of an oil worker.

The deceased oil worker, identified as Mr Austin Ikechukwu Igwe, an uncle to the senior special assistant (SSA) to the chairman of the Niger Delta Development Commission (NDDC) on Youths Matter, George Turner, was caught in the cross fire while exiting the complex of the gas facility.
