Dalori Attack: Gov Shettima Sets Up IDP Feeding Task Force

Borno State governor Kashim Shettima has constituted an Independent Task Force with a separate mandate to supervise the welfare, especially feeding, of the Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) in all the 30 camps within Maiduguri, Borno state capital.

Government officials said the task force became necessary following the recent attacks on Dalori (a village not more than 5km away from the state capital) by Boko Haram terrorists who killed well over 100 persons and torched the entire community.

Following the embarrassing attack on Dalori which caused more IDPs to flood the camps in the state capital, the government found it expedient to better the feeding condition in the camps so as to enable displaced persons stay in the camps until when it becomes safe for them to return.

According to a statement by Isa Gusau, the spokesman to Governor Shettima, "the task force has a mandate of monitoring and evaluating feeding, supply and distribution of food items in all internally displaced persons camps numbering about 30, established by Government in Maiduguri.
