

Murder: Police Nab Suspected Murderer Of MTN Staff

Lagos State police command has arrested a man who used the mobile phones of a murder victim for calls less than 24- hours after the killing.

The Lagos State commissioner of police, Mr. Fatai Owoseni who paraded the suspect, Biodun Fabore at the command headquarters, in Ikeja, yesterday, said Wale

Olawunmi, younger brother of the victim said his elder brother, David Olatunji Olawunmi was "a staff of MTN Communication who left his house in Goshen Estate Redeemed Camp, Mowe, Ogun State, at about 5.30pm to join their staff bus at Mowe tipper garage, was robbed and stabbed to death by unknown hoodlums. His body was recovered at Tipper garage without his

phones.

"Based on the analysis conducted on the activities of the victim's phones, one of the phones was found to have been used on October, 22, 2015 by number 07035921551. It was further revealed that the said phone was subscribed by one Biodun Fabore.

He was consequently arrested and on interrogation, he admitted

being the owner of the said SIM card. He claimed to have bought the said phone but could not produce the source. He also claimed to have given the phone with SIM card to one of his boys whom he could not produce. Obviously the circumstantial evidence has linked him up with the complicity.
