

3 Brothers Remanded In Prison For Alleged Murder

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An Evbuoriarua Chief Magistrate court has remanded three brothers to prison custody for allegedly killing one Edwin Ogiemwense with an AK 47 rifle.

The three brothers, whose names were given as Kelvin Ogiemien, Osaro Solomon Ogiemien and Samuel Ogiemien were arraigned for alleged conspiracy and murder.

They were alleged to have committed the offense on December 22 at Ubiaza village in Ikpoba-Okha local government.

The suspects were alleged to have also shot one Efosa Bright and damaged a Honda Accord car marked BKW 972 AR belonging to one Kennedy Obasuyi.

Presiding Chief Magistrate, Aibueku Ihenyen, declined jurisdiction to entertain the matter and remanded the accused persons in prison custody.

Ihenyen ordered the case file duplicated and forwarded to the state Director of Public Prosecutions for legal advise.
