

Acting DG, Women Centre Dies In Auto Crash

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The National Centre for Women Development, Abuja, has announced the death of its acting director-general, Alhaji Abdulmalik Dauda.

Confirming the incident, the protocol officer to the director-general, Mr Mohammed Aliyu, said Dauda died on yesterday in an auto crash along Abuja-Kaduna expressway while returning from an official assignment.

The deceased took over from Ms Onyeka Onwenu on February 16, 2016, following the removal of 26 heads of government agencies and parastatals.

Born on Aug. 27, 1959, in Niger state, Dauda was survived by two wives and five children.

Aliyu added that the remains of Dauda had been buried according to Islamic rites in his home town in Niger.
