

Nine Feared Killed In 3 Rivers Communities

No fewer than nine persons were feared killed in three communities in Rivers State between Thursday night and yesterday by suspected cultists.

This is as three persons, including two women were kidnapped yesterday along the Port Harcourt-Bakana waterway, when suspected pirates attacked a passenger boat traveling from Bakana community in Degema local government area of the state to Port Harcourt.

LEADERSHIP Sunday gathered that no fewer seven persons where killed by suspected cultists at Idu and Ogbogu communities in Ogbema/Egbema/Ndoni local government area of the state on Thursday night.

The attack on Idu and Ogbogu communities came the same day a chieftain of the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP), Chief Lucky Ajie, was murdered in his compound at Okposi community, also in Ogbema/Egbema/Ndoni local government area of the state by yet to be identified gunmen.

Also, two persons were killed in the early hours of yesterday while no fewer than 10 houses were burnt by suspected cultists who invaded Okwale community in Khana local government area of the state.
