Gunmen Kill 2 In Ogoni Community

...As Army takes free medicare to Ogoniland

Unknown gunmen at the weekend attacked Borobara community in Tai local government area of Rivers State, killing two persons.

A statement signed by the Assistant Director, Army Public Relations, 2 Brigade, Port Harcourt, Captain Eli Lazarus, said the gunmen stormed the community at about 9am on Saturday,

blocked a section of the East-West Road and shot sporadically leading to the death of two persons.

Lazarus stated that troops from the 2 Brigade, Nigerian Army intervened and engaged the gunmen, majority of whom escaped with gunshot wounds, adding that the soldiers succeeded in reopening the East-West Road for traffic.

According to the Army spokesman, items recovered from the gunmen included, one AK 47 rifle, one FN rifle, one G3 rifle and three dane guns, as well as two AK 47 magazines, one FN

magazine, one G3 magazines, one saw and 180 rounds of assorted ammunition.

Meanwhile, the Nigerian Army has carried out a free medical outreach in communities in Ogoniland of Rivers State as part of its 2016 Army Day Celebration.

A statement signed by the Assistant Director, Army Public Relations, 2 Brigade, Port Harcourt, Captain Eli Lazarus, said the free medical outreach will be followed by the presentation of educational materials to schools in Ogoniland, which will start from Monday July 11 and end on Thursday, July 14, 2016.
