Food Poison Ravages Delta Community

Sources said apart from the late girl and the sisters now in critical health condition, Ozoro community in the recent times had allegedly been enveloped with pervasive food poison, a situated, some residents, who spoke to our correspondent on condition of anonymity, described as pathetic and

strange.

Investigation has revealed that the alleged poison may be unconnected with bad water supply to residents of the community at the recent times by

a certain water company.

The current incident which occurred around Erovie Quarters in the Community, close to the main market had left residents, family and sympathizers in a morning mood.
