Police Kill Robbery Suspect, Nab 2 Others In Delta

The Police in Ogwashi-Uku town of Delta State, yesterday, killed an armed robbery suspect along Ogwashi-Uku, Ubulu-Uku highway, with two other members of the gang arrested.

A security source in Ogwashi-Uku told our correspondent that the three-man armed robbery gang had met their waterloo as they were heading towards Ubulu-Uku in a commercial vehicle.

"It was the police at a check point somewhere along Ogwashi-Uku-Ubulu-Uku highway that flagged down the commercial vehicle for search. Immediately the first suspect saw the police, he jumped out of the vehicle and ran into the bush, leaving the two members of his gang and passengers inside the vehicle.

"The action of the first suspect led the police to search the bags of the passengers. It was in that process they saw the other two young men with a bag. On searching the bag, they recovered a cut-to-size barrel gun from them. It was when one of them attempted to escape and he was shot by the police.

"The following day, the second armed robbery suspect took the police to the house of the escaped member of their gang. He was promptly arrested by men of the antirobbery squad as he attempted to escape that morning," said a youth leader from a nearby community, who witnessed the development as it occurred close to the community.
