Police Parades Father, Son, For Alleged Murder In Rivers

The police also recovered one AK 47 rifle, which was used to kill the lawyer, 124 live ammunitions and four AK 47 magazines.

Confessing to the crime when asked, Ezims Aleru, who is 48 years old, a native of Omueke Aluu, in Ikwere, said he did not participate in the kidnap and murder of the

lawyer but only kept the gun used for the operation.

Also, his son, Junior Aleru, 18, who confessed to been a cultist, said he removed the gun from where his father hid it when he discovered that the police were coming for it.

Giving details of how the lawyer was killed, Akokpe, who said he joined the kidnapping gang

when their house was destroyed, explained that they never knew who the lawyer was but just kidnapped him when they saw his flashy car.

He said no one paid them for assassination as been rumoured and that the lawyer was mistakenly killed when the heat was on them, as the gang only wanted ransom.

The Nigeria Police Force, yesterday, paraded four gang members suspected to have kidnapped and killed Rivers state lawyer and human rights lawyer, Ken Atsuwete.
