Vigilante Group Kills 2 Villagers In Birnin Gwari

The Vigilante group members in Birnin Gwari local government area of Kaduna State have been accused of allegedly killing two residents in Kakangi district, .

The younger brother of the deceased, Shehu Rankadede, who gave the names of his slained brothers as Oli Lafia and Rankadede Nana, explained that they left home and went to Biski village to perform Juma'at prayers last Friday but did not return home.

According to Rankadede: "Since then we did not see them again. When we

started looking for them, we gathered that some vigilantes arrested them. We reported the incident to the security.

The security started combing every where and discovered the decompose bodies of my two brothers in the bush"

"We are appealing and calling on Kaduna State government and security agencies to arrest the suspects and bring them to justice without delay. Our brothers are not criminals, we beg Governor Nasir el-Rufai to assist in bringing those behind this barbaric act to justice," he said.

While commenting on incident in a telephone interview with LEADERSHIP, Kaduna State Police Command Public Relations Officer, Usman Aliyu, said, "Please help by telling them to report the incident to the Divisional Police in Birnin Gwari so that investigation will commence."
