

Delta: Police Arrest 2-year-Old Baby Killer Suspect, 2 Others On The Run

Police detectives at Ibusa Police Division near Asaba, Delta State, have arrested a middle aged man (name withheld) who allegedly killed his neighbor two year old son and sucked his entire blood.

The police public relations officer in the State, Mr. Andrew Aniamaka who confirmed this yesterday in Asaba, said that the incident occurred on Friday evening after the suspect had committed the crime and wanted to escape when the detectives acted on a tip off to arrest him while two others in the crime are currently on the run.

It was reliably gathered that the suspect allegedly used a kitchen knife to cut off the throat of the baby and then suck his blood before he tried to escape and was arrested at Umudafe Quarters in Ibusa through the help of residents in the area who immediately alerted the detectives.

Narrating his ordeal to LEADERSHIP Sunday, the father of the little baby who identified himself as Ibrahim said he abandoned his work on the faithful Friday evening when he received a call from his wife of the bizarre killings of his little baby boy by his neighbor adding that his wife was plaiting our head at the front of the compound while the victim was playing with other children in the midst of the suspect. He disclosed that at the time the mother of the victim have finished her hair, the child was no where to be seen, a situation he said prompted the mother of the baby to have raised the alarm and a search party was conducted immediately but the Police image maker added that the suspect upon his arrest confessed to be ritualist saying that he had been involved in ritual activities in the area in the last six years.
