Authorities of the Bayelsa State Command yesterday confirmed the arrest of a 40 years old Husband, Stephen Ogho-Oghene Akpata over the killing of his 33 years old wife, Oyinye Faustina Eze along the Kpansia area of Yenagoa, the state capital.

Also arrested by the Police was a 47 years old man, Moses Otimba, who impregnated the 18 years old junior sister to his wife and killed the baby boy, burying the corpse in a shallow grave along the Ogbogoro area of

the state capital.

The State Commissioner of Police, Asuquo Amba, who made this known yesterday while parading the suspects at the State Police Command in Yenagoa, said the arrest of the suspected wife killer, Stephne Ogho-Oghene Akpata took the special assistance of the Inspector-General of Police and the

Ghana Embassy in Kumasi.

Amba said the suspect killed his wife, who is also a staff of Globacom, in August, 2017 at about 2pm by strangling her with the cord of a pressing iron and stabbing her with a pen knife." One Moses Awo, a staff of Glo Network reported at the Ekeki Police Division that their staff, one Onyinye Faustina Eze, 33 years, did not report to work as expected. On visiting the house in company cemen, the apartment was locked but the television in the room was on and sounding loudly. When the door was forced opened in company of policemen, she was found lying dead in a pool of blood."
