Human Parts Found In Sapele Unsettle Residents

Human parts in Sapele community in Delta State, yesterday, unsettled the residents who have raised the fear of the unknown.

It was gathered that the human parts were found dumped at every nook and cranny in Sapele, especially along new Ogoride road, and Ogbimi drive in the town; a situation which made the residents to call on the security agents to investigate the circumstances surrounding the bizarre activities.

Mr Mohammed Mustafa, the Delta State Police Commissioner, who confirmed the

discovery of the human parts to our reporter, said; "We got report from the Sapele Police Division of the human parts discovered in some parts of the town, we have ordered security beef up, and a full scale investigation into the incident, to bring those behind the acts to book".

Reports said that the human parts were discovered in makeshift buildings, wrapped into different cellophane(s), woods and raffia palm.

But a resident, Omonigho Mabel, who spoke to our reporter said; "The makeshift building had been the abode of a madman, and unknown residents, in fact ritualists also use the abode. We

went to the police to investigate the acts, we are afraid of the situation".

Meanwhile, the image maker in the state, DSP Andrew Aniamaka, has said that one person has been arrested, adding that the suspect is currently being detained at the Sapele Police Division for further investigation.

DSP Aniamaka said; "It was Okada riders who discovered the makeshift building where the remaining parts were also discovered. They perceived offensive odour coming out and they moved into the building, only for them to discover human parts put into cellophane. They alerted the police who then swung into action".
