Anambra Communal Crisis: Soldier Missing, 4 More Die

One of the military personnel in the police/military team deployed to restore peace in the renewed communal clash between the people of Omor and Anaku communities in Ayamelum local government area of Anambra State is now said to be missing.

Also, four more persons have been killed bringing to 10 the number of lives lost in the communal clash which was started in the early hours of Monday.

Several buildings in Anaku community including the dreaded shrine in the town popularly known as Ekwensu (Satan) were said to have been razed with several people inflicted with bullet wounds.

A gang of gun-wielding hoodlums led by one person popularly known in the area as

Vulture was said to have invaded Omor community between 4.30am and 5am on Monday and killed five persons in the town among who were three natives and two non-natives. A woman was said to have been killed in Anaku during the Monday attacks.

LEADERSHIP however gathered that the crisis escalated yesterday as four male persons in Anaku were reported to have

been killed bringing the total number of deaths in the community to five just as already recorded in Omor town.

The spokesperson of the state police command, deputy superintendent of police, DSP Ikenga Tochukwu while confirming the incident said that the command has declared one Mr Nnamdi Maduneke wanted in connection with the communal crisis.
