

Troops Kill Terrorists, Recover Weapons In Kaduna

Troops of 1 Division Nigerian
Army and Air Component
of Operation Whirl Punch
have killed five bandits and
recovered weapons in Kaduna
State.

In a statement, the
deputy director, Army Public

Relations, 1 Division, Lt Col
Musa Yahaya said the troops
in a bid to create a very
conducive environment for
the peaceful and successful
conduct of the 2023 general
elections and deny bandits
freedom of action carried
out aggressive fighting patrol
that lasted over 48 hours.

He said the troops

successfully cleared Mando
- Sabon Birni - Maidaro -
Dogon Dawa, Galadimawa,
Saulawa, Farin Ruwa and
Polewire villages respectively
and neutralised five bandits
and recovered 10 motorcycles
from the bandits while
several other motorcycles
were destroyed.

Other items recovered

include two AK 47 rifles,
five Improvised Explosive
Devices, two mobile phones,
uniforms and magazines.

The General Officer
Commanding 1 Division
Nigerian Army charged
the troops not to relent
until banditry, kidnapping,
terrorism and all other crimes
are brought to an end.
