

Cultists Behead Constabulary, Dump Body In Well

Akwa Ibom State Police Command has taken over investigation of the gruesome murder of one of its Special Constabularies, Uwem Cletus, attached to his community, Ikot Abasi Akpan, in Mkpato Enin local government area of the state.

LEADERSHIP gathered that the late special constabulary, who served as a security liaison in the cult-infested Mkpato Enin communities where cases of kidnapping, armed robbery and other violent crimes have been rife for some years now, was seized by the local bandits, who beheaded him and later dumped his remains in a community well, for allegedly working as police informant.

However, the police public relations officer (PPRO), SP Odiko Macdon, speaking in an interview with journalists in Uyo, the state capital, said the commissioner of Police (CP), Olatoye Durosinmi, was very disturbed by the sad incident and had since mobilized operatives of the command to comb for the perpetrators in their various hideouts to face the law.

He said: "The late Uwem Cletus, was one of our special constabularies. When we got that report, first, he was declared missing, and the police sent a search party, it was during the investigation that we unraveled the fact that he was beheaded and thrown into a well.
