Police Kill 2 Bandits, Recover Rustled Cows

The Katsina State police command said its men killed two suspected bandits and recovered cows and one motorcycle from bandits.

A press statement issued by CSP Gambo Isah and made available to LEADERSHIP Weekend said they responded based on a distress call received on a group of terrorists shooting sporadically with AK-47 rifles and attacked the residence of one Sarkin Fulani at Danmarke village, Dangwarwa district in Kurfi LGA of the state.

He said; "The DPO Kurfi Division led police patrol teams to the area, engaged the hoodlums in a fierce gun duel and successfully repelled them. In the course of scanning the scene, two bandits were neutralised and all the rustled cows were recovered.

"Many of the terrorists were reasonably believed to have been neutralised and/or escaped the scene with gunshot wounds. Search parties are combing the nearest bushes to arrest them and/or recover their dead bodies."

He added the command was appealing to members of the communities around the area to report to the nearest police station any person found with a suspected injury.
