Court Jails Keke– NAPEP Rider 21years Over Murder

A High Court sitting in Ganye, Adamawa State has convicted and jailed Keke-NAPEP rider, Nuhu Pius to 21 years imprisonment for murder.

Pius was sentenced for killing Gabriel Solomon, during a free for all fight at a tea joint in Trigali village, Ganye local government area of the state

Justice Maxwell Pukuma said the court tried and found Pius guilty on one count charge of "culpable homicide."

Delivering his judgement,
Pukuma declared that the
sentence will start running
from the day of the convict's
remand, and that the sentence
is without an option of fine.

The convict, Nuhu, was arraigned before the court on 14th April. 2022 where he pleaded not guilty to the alleged offence.

The prosecution told the court that the convict had engaged in a fight with Wari, and in the course of it, the deceased who was trying to separate them, hit the convict with a stick on his head.
