Troops Kill Terrorist, Recover Weapons

Troops of Sector 3 Multinational
Joint Task Force (MNJTF)
deployed at Magumeri,
Nigeria, killed one terrorist and
recovered arms and ammunition
in a successful raid.

The military public information officer - MNJTF Ndjamena Lt.-Col. Abubakar Abdullahi said the feat was achieved when troops conducted a proactive fighting patrol aimed at clearing the remnants of Boko Haram

terrorists in the region.

He said the successful operation resulted in the neutralisation of one Boko Haram terrorist and a remarkable step towards ensuring peace and stability in the area.

He said during the operation, the troops uncovered and engaged a group of Boko Haram terrorists at Dugushewa Village, relentlessly pursuing them as they attempted to flee leading to the elimination of one Boko Haram insurgent.
