

## 6 Die In Ondo Road Accident

No fewer than six people yesterday afternoon lost their lives and one was injured in a fatal road accident in Akure, the Ondo State capital.

The accident which occurred along Akure-Owo Road involved one red MAN Diesel truck and one ash-colour Toyota Sienna marked FFN 310 PU.

The accident occurred at about 1:39 pm around 3km away from Akure Airport.

Confirming the accident in a statement made available to LEADERSHIP, the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Ondo State commander, Mr. Ezekiel SonAllah, said six male adults died while one female adult was injured out of 8 people involved.

SonAllah attributed the

causes of the accident as the speed violation, wrongful overtaken and loss of control.

The FRSC commander disclosed that the items recovered from the scene of the accident including money and phones.

According to him, the items have been handed over to the police operatives from Ogbese in Akure North local

government area of the state.

He further disclosed that the six corpses had been deposited at the general hospital morgue, Akure while obstruction had been cleared and the vehicles.

SonAllah, therefore, called on motorists to always abide by the prescribed speed limit and commercial drivers must ensure they install speed-limiting devices in their vehicles.
