

Group Seeks Probe Into Killing Of Consultant

A civil society organisation, the Youth and Environmental Advocacy Centre (YEAC-Nigeria) has called on the police, to launch an investigation into the killing of its financial management consultant, Dr Barine Lenee.

Lenee, aged 41, was allegedly stabbed to death along the Trans-Amadi-Slaughter area of Port Harcourt on Saturday, September 30, 2023, while returning to Port Harcourt from Uyo, Akwa Ibom State.

The lifeless body, which was dumped along the road by his assailants, beside his car, with all his personal belongings intact, except his phone, was recovered on Sunday, October 1, 2023.

The deceased, until his death, was also the Head of Internal Audit Department/Accountant at the Port Harcourt Water Corporation (PHWC).

YEAC-Nigeria executive director, Fyneface Dumnamene Fyneface, in a statement issued in Port Harcourt yesterday, called on the police to do all it can to bring the perpetrators of the dastardly act to book within the shortest possible time.
