Boko Haram Kills 3 Passengers, Abduct Others In Yobe

Three passengers have been killed in an attack by suspected Boko Haram terrorists on Kamuya village of Biu local government area on the Biu-Damaturu Federal Highway in Yobe State.

LEADERSHIP Friday gathered that the terrorists also abducted some passengers after killing three of them.

A source from one of the victims said the incident happened near Kamuya, a Yobe/Borno border community along the Biu-Damaturu Road.

According to him, only three of the passengers who were not Muslims were abducted, while others were freed by the terrorists.

He added, "They were coming from Biu in Borno State, the attackers stopped their commercial vehicle and picked four of them who were Christians into the bush, killing three of them; we saw their corpses on social media today."

He lamented, "We only sighted three corpses of the four persons abducted. We did not know the whereabouts of the other person."
