Soldiers Kill 2 Terrorists In Kaduna, Recover Weapons

Soldiers deployed for counter-terrorism operations in Kaduna State have successfully ambushed and killed two terrorists on a mission to attack communities in Kagarko LGA of Kaduna State.

A statement by the Nigerian Army on its official social media handle said troops, acting on credible intelligence, intercepted four armed terrorists on motorbikes at a known terrorists' crossing point in Kurmin Aja, Kagarko local government area of Kaduna State, just moments before they could strike.

The statement said troops in a well-executed ambush, engaged the terrorists in a firefight and killed two while others fled with gunshot wounds into a nearby forest.

The development thereby prevented the loss of innocent lives in the community.

The troops recovered two AK-47 Rifles, 30 rounds of 7.62mm ammunition, three magazines, and two motorbikes belonging to the terrorists.

The Army, therefore, urged all law-abiding citizens to remain vigilant and promptly report any suspicious activity to security agencies.
