## 4 Women Die In Bauchi Ghastly Auto Crash

About four women died in a ghastly road crash in Dutsin-hari, a community along Jalam-Lanzai road in Darazo local government area of Bauchi State on Wednesday.

LEADERSHIP gathered that the women died while heading to Sade market. However, the vehicle driver was overspeeding. Hence, he lost control and somersaulted.

The women who lost their lives in the crash were identified as Aishatu Salihu,25; Furera Haladu, 25; Zuwaira Dandija,19 and Lahala Muhammed, 41.

Similarly, many other victims of

the crash were rushed to hospital for medical treatment.

Bauchi Police Command spokesperson SP Ahmed Wakil confirmed the incident to reporters, saying over 30 passengers were aboard the vehicle.

"Many people were injured. When the police took them to the hospital, the doctor confirmed four people dead," he said.

Wakil said the Command commemorated the deceased's family and warned drivers to observe traffic rules.
