Flood Kills 11, Ravages 529 Communities In Niger BY ABU NMODU, Minna

The Niger State Emergency
Management Agency NSEMA
has said 11 people have been
killed by flood in the state with
529 communities affected.

Director general of
NSEMA, Abdullahi Baba
Arah, disclosed this yesterday
while giving an update on the
various flood disasters in the
state.

He said, "Sadly, we have lost 11 people to the flood, five in Mokwa, two each in Shiroro and Munya and one cach in Katcha and Rijau local government areas. It is pertinent to report that as a result of this year's flood, 529 communities in 19 out of the 25 local government areas in the state have been affected.
