



Bandits Attack Hospital, Kidnap Staff, Kill ABU Best Graduating Medical Doctor

Bandits have attacked the General Hospital in Kankara Local Government Area of Katsina State, killed a medical doctor and kidnapped a yet-to-be-identified number of hospital staff.

The attack occurred around 7:00 pm Tuesday, during which Dr Murta-la Sale Dandashire was shot.

According to a resident of the area, who spoke on the condition of anony-

mity, the bandits invaded the hospital premises in a coordinated attack, creating panic among staff and patients and shooting sporadically.

The resident confirmed that the injured doctor, who was shot in the leg, is currently alive and receiving treatment at an undisclosed medical facility.

Dr Dandashire, a Medical graduate of Ahmadu Bello University (ABU) Zaria, garnered 13 awards, including the overall best graduating student in the Class of 2019, was shot at the General Hospital while attending to pa-

tients who came to seek medical intervention.

Dr Dandashire graduated from ABU Zaria as the best student in Haematology, overall best in Community medicine, best in biochemistry, best in Physiology, best in Project Community medicine, best in Anatomy and Surgery, best in Anatomy, overall best in Surgery, best in chemical pathology, Best in Pathology, best in Histopathology, NMA Kaduna award for overall best graduating MBBS student and overall best-graduating Student.
