

Student Kills Final-year Colleague While Learning Driving

University of Delta (UNIDEL) has been thrown into mourning as a 100-level student accidentally killed a final-year nursing student while learning how to drive.

The tragic accident occurred in Agbor, Ika south local government area of Delta State.

According to reports, the

young woman, whose name has yet to be disclosed, was being taught how to drive by her boyfriend, an alleged internet fraudster (Yahoo boy).

During the driving session, she lost control of the vehicle and veered off the road, hitting pedestrians.

One of the victims, Awele Eluemunor, a final-year student of the College of Nursing, Agbor, was

killed instantly.

Awele, who was set to graduate in November, tragically lost her life at the scene.

Two other individuals sustained critical injuries and were rushed to the hospital for emergency treatment.

Eyewitnesses revealed that immediately after the accident, the boyfriend, who owned the car, fled

the scene, abandoning the young driver.

Authorities have yet to confirm whether the suspect has been apprehended, while investigations into the incident continued.

When contacted, the state's Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), SP Edafe Bright confirmed the incident, noting that one died while another was injured.
