The joint operation, according to the state police command's spokesman, SP Ramhan Nansel, was in collaboration with the Nigerian Army and vigilante groups.

Nansel said Abdullahi was a well-known armed robber and kidnapper who had been on the command's wanted list for multiple offenses.

"One accomplice managed to escape with gunshot wounds, and a manhunt is currently underway to apprehend the fleeing suspect. The deceased suspect's body has been evacuated to Akwanga General Hospital Mortuary for post-mortem examination," he said.
