
Man Killed, Another Injured Over Dog Theft

A man identified as Peter has been killed by mobs in Lushi, a community on the outskirts of the Bauchi metropolis, for allegedly stealing a dog.

LEADERSHIP reports that Peter's accomplice, Dokagk Danlami, 38, was matched and beaten to a coma. He was rushed to Abubakar Tafawa Balewa University Teaching Hospital

(ATBUTH) for treatment.

Confirming the incident on Thursday, the Spokesperson of Bauchi Police Command, CSP Ahmed Wakil, said Danladi sustained wounds on his head.

"Peter, whose surname remains unidentified, was found at the scene and was regrettably declared dead by medical personnel," he said.

Wakil said the investigation is currently underway. "The command is diligently working to ensure a thorough examination of this incident, focusing on identifying all individuals involved in the mob assault."

He said the Commissioner of Police, CP Sani-Omolori Aliyu, described the act as barbaric and detrimental to our nation's legal framework.
