

Yobe Varsity Student Dies, 4 Others Injured In Fatal Accident

A 100-level student of Department of Biology Education, Yobe State University (YSU), Amina Yakubu, lost her life while four others sustained varying degrees of injuries in a fatal incident that occurred on Saturday.

A statement obtained by LEADERSHIP on Sunday signed by Abdulmumin Kolo Gulani, Office of the Vice-Chancellor, announced Yakubu's death, stating that the students' community was deeply saddened by the tragic loss.

According to Gulani, Miss Yakubu lost her life in a tragic accident that occurred around 5:30 pm on Gujba Road near the University's Gate, involving a tricycle popularly called 'Keke NAPEP' that was crushed by a vehicle.



Gulani said four other persons sustained various degrees of injuries in the accident, including one of the University's matrons.
