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Jos: 3 Killed In Fresh Attack

Three persons have been confirmed dead in an attack in Kwata, a small village in Jos South local government area of Plateau state.

This attack is the second in three days, as it would be recalled that, two days ago an attack in Gvero in the same local government also led to the death of a 27-year-old at the border between Gero in Jos South and Rafin Baura in Bassa Local Government areas of Plateau state.

LEADERSHIP WEEKEND gathered that the assailants came at about 11: 30 pm at night shooting sporadically in the air, and went into the house of one Mr. James Dung, a staffer of Grand Cereals in Jos; shot him in the head and killed two others.

The Commander of the special Joint- Task Force on Jos crisis (JTF) "Operation Save Haven", Brig. Gen. Hassan Umaru, who spoke to LEADERSHIP WEEKEND in a telephone interview, stated that only one person was killed and three others were wounded in the attack..

His words: "At about 11: 30 pm Thursday night, the house of Mr James a staffer of Grand Cereal at Kwata was targeted and attacked; he was shot and killed by his assailants and three other men injured in the attack." Further adding that, "so far, investigation indicates that Mr James was the sole target of the attack, and it was an assassination attack".

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
