# Auto Accident Claims 6 In Zamfara







Six people yesterday lost their lives while about 22 others sustained serious injuries following an auto crash which occurred along Dankurmi Road in Dansadau District of Maru Local Government Area of the state

The accident involved a large six-wheeler Truck which was said to have left Sokoto the previous night, loaded with over 30 passengers on their way to attend a market session in Dankurmi village.

One of the rescuers at the scene of the accident, Mallam Sani Ya'r nagge, told LEADERSHIP that the truck was carrying passengers from Sokoto when the front tyre burst at Jangeme Village and somersault into a very large ditch and almost scattered into pieces.

He also explained that his vehicle and two other vans immediately conveyed the dead and the injured to the Gusau Federal Medical Centre.




