

Auto crash claims six in Ibadan

RESIDENTS of Mobil area, Ring Road in Ibadan, the Oyo State capital yesterday woke up to face a grim sight of six corpses by the road.

The deceased were victims of a motor accident which occurred in the early hours of the day.

The victims, who were one young lady and four young men, were said to have left one of the highly rated night clubs located at Ajeigbe area of Ibadan where they spent the night. They dropped off a lady before getting

to the spot of the accident.

It was gathered that the driver of the Toyota Camry moving from Challenge was on top speed. Residents said that the car lost control on getting to the Oni and Sons Bus stop and rammed into an electricity pole before somersaulting to the other lane of the expressway where it blocked and hit a BMW car that was moving towards Challenge.

Residents disclosed that the

owner of the BMW who died on the spot was coming from night vigil around 5 am when the Camry hit his vehicle, leading to his death.

A resident said: "When I got here this morning, I saw the two cars, that is, the BMW and the Toyota Camry. I learnt that the accident occurred around 2.am. I saw about six people. I don't know whether they are police or FRSC people but they had towed the vehicles away from here this morning."
