Killer meal: CMD blames police

THE Chief Medical Director, National Hospital, Abuja, Dr Olusegun Ajuwon, has blamed the police for the hospital's failure to carry out autopsy on the bodies of the family of five who died after eating contaminated food.

Police said two persons are in their net over the killings.
Livinus Iliya, his wife and their three children died after a meal three weeks ago at I librohi, village

two weeks ago at Ukpebi village, a suburb of Abuja, and some 15 kms behind highbrow Asokoro District.

Ajuwon told reporters yesterday in Abuja that the hospital could not carry out the autopsy due to the failure of the police to

write a coroner's request to the

hospital.

"Once there is a request/report from the police to carry out an autopsy, it becomes official, money is not the issue here, but nobody saw such request," he

said.
