

# Two killed in Kano governor's convoy crash

KANO State Governor Ibrahim Shekarau's five-man advanced party security team, made up of police officers, State Security Service (SSS), and protocol officers, including the driver were involved in a motor accident along Yar-mariya village in Tudun-wada Jos Road.

Two people died. They are the Protocol Officer and a police CIB Officer. The rest sustained injury.

The governor's team left the Government House yesterday morning for a trip to Plateau State before the arrival of the governor.

The accident was said to have occurred when one of the tyres exploded while on high speed, causing the driver to lose control of the car. It skidded off the road and crashed into a big tree, leaving the vehicle severely damaged.

The survivors were first taken to Tudun-wada General Hospital, before they were transferred to Aminu Kano Teaching Hospital, while the dead were taken to the Government House.
