

Agagu condoles with fire victims

ONDO State Governor Olusegun Agagu yesterday condoled with victims of last Monday's night fire that claimed four lives and razed houses, shops, vehicles and property worth millions of naira in Owaro Oka, Akoko.

Agagu described the incident caused by the fuel spill from a tanker that fell in the heart of the community as a disaster and great calamity. However, he said the state government had already begun processes of providing relief to the victims.

The governor, who was represented by his deputy, Otunba Omolade Oluwateru, during a visit to the scene, said the local government authorities had been commissioned to get the estimate of the number of persons, houses and property involved with a view to alleviating the impact on the people.
