## Eight killed in Edo clash

**ESIDENTS** of the University town of Okada in Edo State e fled the area have following a violent clash between Fulani cattle herdsmen and some settlers over allegation that the herdsmen raped and eventually murdered a female settler. Eight persons and

several heads of cattle were reportedly killed the violent confrontation that left 12 persons with serious

injuries.

The clash, which started o<u>n Tuesday</u>, reportedly led to the death of two of the herdsmen, while continuation of the clash <u>yesterda</u>y left additional per sons dead before policemen sent to the town succeeded in restoring some measure of order.

The herdsmen were accused of raping and killing a girl, an action that drew the ire of the settlers who attacked

the herdsmen.

A native of the community who intervened to prevent the attack on the Fulani cattle herdsmen, was himself attacked, brutalised and his house vandalised. State

Commissioner of Police, Mr. Bala Hassan, who confirmed the incident, said he had deployed policemen, warning that people should not take the laws into their hands.
