weather.

Eye witnesses said the stormy weather which later led to the mishap of the boat occurred shortly after the

boat had left Angiama communities where some passengers had earlier disembarked.

With the rough weather that caused heavy waves to enter the heavily loaded boat, it then sank with almost every passenger on board, sources disclosed. The cloudy weather was followed with a heavy rainfall which made it difficult for immediate rescue operations, it was learnt.
