

# Robbers kill policeman, bank worker in raid

**A** MOBILE policeman and a bank worker were yesterday afternoon killed at Oshodi, Lagos during a raid by armed robbers on a first generation bank.

Another mobile policeman was also seriously wounded in the incident.

The bandits, about seven in number, stormed the bank around noon.

They went into the banking hall like normal customers who had come for transactions.

However, inside the banking hall, the hoodlums announced their mission and ordered everybody to lie face down.

The robbers operated

successfully, but on their way out of the banking hall, they encountered a little resistance from the policemen on guard duty.

It was during the gun

battle between the hoodlums and the police that the robbers' bullet hit one of the policemen in the head and the bank official in the chest.

While the policeman died instantly, the bank official

died on the way to the hospital.

The sporadic shooting of the hoodlums while escaping forced motorists to abandon their vehicles on the Oshodi-Apapa Expressway.

The policeman that was killed only went to visit his colleagues at the bank.
