

Two policemen killed in Port Harcourt

TWO mobile policemen were shot dead yesterday by hoodlums operating on the Bonny River in Rivers State.

The Nation gathered that the two met their end when they were escorting a Nigerian Liquefied Natural Gas (NLNG) boat from Port Harcourt to Bonny.

The boat had cruised off with expectation of hitting Bonny safely but a few kilometers to Bonny jetty, a group of hoodlums struck, killing the two armed mobile policemen.

With the policemen dead, the hoodlums had a field day robbing all the people in the boat.

The Police Commissioner in the state, Mr Felix Ogbaudu confirmed the incident and lamented the killing of his men.

Bonny River has of recent become a source of concern to the users due to frequent attacks on company boats on the water way.
