

Four killed in Lagos clash

FOUR persons, including a school boy were among those killed yesterday in a fresh clash at Ajah, Lagos State.

Part of the palace of the traditional ruler, Oba Fatai Olumegbon, some shops in the area and the community market at Ajah junction were also set ablaze.

The police spokesman, Mr Olubode Ojajuni, a superintendent (SP) could not confirm the number of casualties and said the cause of fighting has not been established.

Ojajuni, however, confirmed that several people were wounded in the incident. 17 others, including two people caught with four litres of fuel, have been arrested.

He noted that following the deployment policemen, led by the Deputy Commissioner (Operations), Mr Zarchus Olisan, peace was gradually returning to the area.

Oba Olumegbon was also sighted at the Command headquarters in the evening.
