

Policeman shot at Ogbomoso violence

VIOLENCE again broke out in Ogbomoso, Oyo state yesterday as some thugs swooped on the house of the Labour Party(LP) Senatorial candidate, Abdul Fatai Tayo Buhari and attempted to set it ablaze.

In the melee, one policeman was shot. Buhari's

BMW 5 series car was damaged along with four other vehicles. An unconfirmed report said apart from the cop, another person was shot.

Police Commissssioner Mr. Jonathan Johnson confirmed that one of his men was shot. He was asked to

comment on the crises being experienced in the state. He had just attended a security meeting with the governor of Oyo State Senator Rashidi Ladoja.

Hon. Buhari had last Friday told journalists that twenty one vehicles in his campaign convoy were damaged the previous day at Ilero in Oke Ogun area

of the state when the same set of thugs attacked them and injured the Okeho Police Divisional Police Officer (DPO).

He said that thugs in the convoy of two PDP chieftains, Alhaji Lamidi Adedibu and the deputy governor, Chief Bayo Alao-Akala, had attacked his supporters and were shouting,

"where is Buhari?". He said he escaped the attack through the grace of the monarch of the community who shielded him.

Reacting to the allegation, Prince Dotun Oyelade (Media Director for Alao-Akala Campaign Organisation) said instead that it was the LP supporters that attacked them.
