The AC leader in Odo-Otin Local Government, Mr Wunmi Oke was allegedly attacked by thugs who raticled polling centres at Oyan town, while a member of the House of Representatives was said to have been arrested for allegedly

been arrested for allegedly shooting an AC member, Mr Toke Taiwo.

It was a reign of terror at Ile-Ife, Iragbiji, Ede and Ikirun as thugs, led by some Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) chieftains, shot indiscriminately into the

indiscriminately into the air and scared voters away, while they stuffed ballot boxes with thumb printed ballot papers.
