

# Man, 60, two sisters charged with alleged murder

**A** 60-year old man, Adewuyi Zaccheus and two sisters, Iyabo and Maria Ogunwobi were yesterday arraigned before an Osogbo Magistrate's Court for alleged murder.

Zaccheus was accused of killing Isiaka Adegoke, 35, at Ipetu-Ijesa on April 19 when he allegedly shot him at the back with a gun.

Adegoke was said to, have died as a result of the gunshot injuries. The plea of the

accused person was not taken.

His counsel, Mr Remi Ayoade, prayed the court to adjourn the case because of the nature of the offence allegedly committed by his client.

The magistrate, Mr Adebayo Ajala ordered that Zaccheus be remanded in prison custody and adjourned the case till June 4, for mention.

Also, the Ogunwobi sis-

ters were said to have killed Abraham Ujah at Oguro town near Ejigbo in Osun State at about 6: 00 a.m on April 18.

They were arraigned on a two-count charge of conspiracy to commit felony, to wit murder of Ujah.

Their plea were not taken, while their counsel, Ayoade also asked for adjournment.

Mr Ajala, also ordered that the accused persons be remanded in prison custody till June 1 and directed that

the case file be referred to the Director of Public Prosecution (DPP) for legal advice.

Meanwhile, the court granted bail to three persons, who were docked for politically related offences.

They were brought to court for alleged unlawful gathering and conduct likely to cause breach of peace.

Ajala granted them bail for N100,000 and one surety each in like sum, adding that sureties must be civil servants not below level 12.
